Update on Scholarships and Grants

## Higher Education Scholarships

- 52 students were awarded scholarships: 39 bachelor degrees, 6 associate degrees, 1 vocational degree, 2 other degrees, and 4 theology scholarships.
- 61 applications were received; 9 applicants did not receive scholarships because they did not meet criteria or because their applications were not complete.
- Scholarships ranged from \$350-\$1500. Awards were communicated and distributed by 10/30/20.
- Awards were available for full-time and part-time study toward the first baccalaureate degree or certification at colleges, universities, and vocational schools, and toward first masters degree programs for church vocations.

## **COVID Emergency Need Grants for Higher Education Students**

- To date, 9 of the 10 applicants received have been awarded grants up to \$500. The one applicant who did not receive a grant did not meet the criteria or had an incomplete application.
- Applications are due by 12/4/20. As of 11/30/20, we have received 2 additional applications.
- Awards up to \$500 and are available to those who qualify for Higher Education Scholarships and who have emergency financial need due to the pandemic.

## Racial Ethnic Grants

- Five awardees (of 12 applications) learned on 11/30/20 that they received \$2,500 or \$5,000.
- Awards <\$5000 to predominantly Black, Indigenous, and People of Color (BIPOC) congregations to supplement their mission. Deadline extended to 10/31/20; funds distributed 11/30/20.

## **New Covenant Grants**

- Eight awardees (of 19 applications) learned on 11/30/20 that they received between \$1,800 & \$5,000.
- Awards up to \$5000 for congregations, institutions, and organizations associated with the PC(USA) working to address congregational development and transformation; multicultural and justice ministries; and ministries in higher education. Deadline 9/30/20; funds distributed 11/30/20.
