



a. Please provide a brief description of the program/project for which funding is requested:

Flat Rock Homes, Flat Rock, Ohio, a non-profit mission supported by Firelands PC, hopes to improve the lives of those served and those who work within the Care and Community Services Center by building the TRL (Transforming Lives, Restoring Hope, Living Faith) which entails: Upgrades to current campus playground with appropriately sized, accessible equipment, demolition of several on-campus buildings (aged), a Prayer Labyrinth, and a Memorial Walking Trail. Those served by Flat Rock are persons with Intellectual Disabilities/Developmental Disabilities (ID/DD), their families, and persons with critical needs through dedication to caring and excellence that demonstrates Christian values. The Community Svcs program helps transition those at the Home into society.

b. Is the program/project ongoing, or is it a new initiative (please explain):

Project TRL fundraising started on Giving Tuesday 2020. Firelands PC also began a missional relationship with Flat Rock in 2020 by supporting their 154th Birthday Celebration with a gift of \$154 to help with the need for replacement of worn-out air conditioners in campus buildings, and other necessary equipment/building updates with an aging facility. Since then we have received their newsletter monthly that updates current projects, fundraisers, successes, and other good news.

c. Are funds being received from other sources to support this program/project? If so, what are the sources, and how much?

The project start-up fundraiser in 2020 raised nearly \$25,000 from generous donors. Recently, Rural King (a Farm and Home Store) raised \$157.70 through giving of 10% of store receipts to Flat Rock in support of project goals. Other than what is publicly shared by Flat Rock, Firelands is not privy to their financial information/private or other donors. As stated here and above, community support is crucial to their work. Fundraisers, donations, and grants help finance the needs of the Home.

d. Background (more detailed description of program/project, and please show partnership with other mid councils):

Firelands is not knowledgeable of Flat Rock's partnership with other mid councils. Donors are community based and ecumenical. The Home was originally an orphanage started in the 1800's by the Ecumenical Association and the Evangelical United Brethren Church. When ruined by fire, it was rebuilt into what it is today 154 years ago, hence the need of updating with new and ongoing projects.
